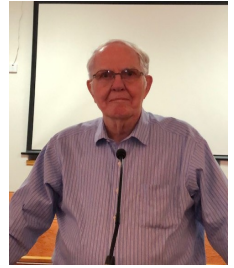


The Legacy of

Becoming a Disaster Relief Volunteer provides an excellent opportunity for hands on service to people in need. Attending training does not obligate you to serve but is necessary before serving. Please note you must be 18 years of age and a member of a Missouri Baptist church to be certified as a Missouri Disaster Relief Volunteer. All trainees must submit a background check request, attend Introduction to Disaster Relief as well as retrain every five years in any class of your choice to remain a certified volunteer.

What Is An "Association?"

Associations are made up of churches who join together to get things done together that they can't do alone. They are formed on a regional basis, sometimes a county or group of adjoining counties. Missouri has 63 Baptist associations who relate in a cooperative fashion with the Missouri Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention.

Within the Association each church remains autonomous – independent and self governing – yet they partner together to fulfill the mission of Christ. Together they become more effective at reaching their ministry area and building the family of Christ.
