

What Is An "Association?"

Associations are made up of churches who join together to get things done together that they can't do alone. They are formed on a regional basis, sometimes a county or group of adjoining counties. Missouri has 63 Baptist associations who relate in a cooperative fashion with the Missouri Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention.

Within the Association each church remains autonomous – independent and self governing – yet they partner together to fulfill the mission of Christ. Together they become more effective at reaching their ministry area and building the family of Christ.
