### **Registration and Check-In**

Please make every effort to register two weeks prior to your camp date. Fill out health and medication forms PRIOR to coming to camp. All medications will be collected by the camp nurse upon check-in.

### **Items to Pack: (youth listed on youth form)**

Sturdy shoes, light jacket if needed  
Bug spray  
Socks, underwear, sleepwear  
Flashlight

#### **Pre-Teen Camp List:**

Bible, Notebook, Mission Offering, Pen  
Pillow and bedding or sleeping bag  
Towels and washcloths, soap  
Toothbrush/toothpaste, shower shoes  
Shampoo, comb/brush  
Deodorant, personal items  
Sport clothes for 4 days, sturdy shoes  
Socks, underwear, sleepwear  
Swimwear (no bikinis), cover-up  
Light jacket  
Flashlight, Bug Spray  
Bag for dirty clothes

\*Any items that have been left at the camp will be held for 30 days. Please contact the office to make arrangements for pick up. They will be given to a charity organization after 30 days.

### **RULES FOR CAMPERS & LEADERS**

- 1.** All Medication(s) MUST BE GIVEN TO THE NURSE upon arriving at camp. This includes all prescription medications and all over-the-counter medications.
- 2.** Campers Must Attend All Camp Activities.
- 3.** Campgrounds must be respected. No destructive use of camp property. If you have trash, find a trash can.
- 4.** No profane language or bullying will be tolerated.
- 5.** Campers needing to leave the group for any reason must have leader's permission and at least one other camper with them.
- 6.** No public displays of affection.
- 7.** You must be in your cabin from lights out through morning rise. (except bath houses) (NO late-night cabin raids or switching).
- 8.** Campers may use radios, iPods, cell phones when NOT engaged in camp activities and when NOT a distraction.
- 9.** Campers must always wear shoes outside of cabin.
- 10.** Dress code Will Be Enforced at all times. Cabin leaders will make final decisions on all clothing.
- 11.** No hiking allowed on the trails/road without a leader.
- 12.** Food items are discouraged, however any snacks brought must be in sealed containers.
